- Wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/hockey manager. This includes – navy blue or club shirt, navy blue shorts or skorts, yellow socks, trainers [no studs or blades], goal keeping kit, mouth guard and shin pads.
- Pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Not smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Not consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
